SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

The Scholarship will offer the successful candidate three fourths (75%) of the total cost of education (less Federal Financial Aid received) which is defined as tuition and fees, books, housing and meals for 2 academic years to obtain a bachelor's degree in the college or university of his/her choice anywhere in the continental United States.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. The applicant must be a citizen of the United States.
- 2. The applicant must be a graduate of a public or private high school in <u>South Brevard County</u>, defined as South of Pineda Causeway.
- 3. The applicant must anticipate imminently earning his/her associate's degree from Eastern Florida State College.
- 4. The applicant must graduate with a 2.5 grade point average or above from Eastern Florida State College.
- 5. The applicant must have a financial need.

TERMS

- 1. This scholarship is for three fourths (75%) of the total cost of education (less Federal Financial aid received), which is defined as tuition and fees, books, housing and meals for two years up to \$50,000 per year.
- 2. <u>If living off campus, financial arrangements must be approved by the AAUW Scholarship Committee.</u> Student will be required to submit request to EFSC, who will forward to AAUW.
- 3. The applicant must maintain a 2.0 grade point average (based on a 4 point system) in order to remain on the scholarship.
- 4. The recipient of the scholarship <u>will not be permitted to be gainfully employed d</u>uring the academic year without the consent of Eastern Florida State College and the American Association of University Women, Melbourne Branch. Student will be required to submit request to EFSC, who will forward to AAUW.
- 5. The scholarship will be awarded only after the student has been awarded a degree by EFSC and been accepted by a university.
- 6. If the student fails to maintain the scholarship criteria, this award will be rescinded.
- 7. The scholarship is reimbursement based. The recipient will be required to submit documentation after each semester to verify expenses (tuition and fees, books, housing and meals), financial aid, employment, and grades.
- 8. <u>Recipient will be required to attend a meeting with the AAUW and report to the EFSC Foundation and AAUW each semester.</u>

SELECTION OF RECIPIENT

- 1. The selection of the recipient shall be based upon the applicant's career goals and academic record.
- 2. This scholarship is to be awarded to an individual with a financial need. This scholarship will enable the recipient to obtain a bachelor's degree at the college of his or her choice, preference given to EFSC Bachelor Program students.
- 3. The finalist may be called in for an interview.
- 4. The decision of the AAUW Scholarship Committee shall be final.
- 5. A new scholarship shall be awarded each year unless the AAUW determines that there are no worthy applicants.
